Senior College Uniform Guidelines (Years 10-12)

These guidelines outline the Senior College uniform and co-curricular teamwear requirements at St Andrew's Cathedral School. The school uniform is compulsory for all students when travelling to and from school, during school hours, and at school functions. Without exception, all students are to conform to the following uniform requirements in order to ensure the highest possible standard of dress.

The Uniform Shop stocks all uniform requirements

All school uniform items are to be purchased from the Uniform Shop, located on Level 6 of the School. Only socks, stockings and shoes may be purchased elsewhere in compliance with these Guidelines. School shoes are available from the Uniform Shop for your convenience. All articles of clothing are to be clearly labelled and kept in good order.

New students joining St Andrew's Cathedral School

New students starting at St Andrew's Cathedral School, must book an appointment for a complete uniform fitting. Stationery packs must be pre-ordered at your child's fitting and will be distributed to your child on the first day of school. Allow approximately 45 minutes for your fitting. Acceptable methods of payment are cash and EFTPOS. No AMEX.

Online Uniform Shop

Once your child has started at the School you will be able to access the Online Uniform Shop via our Parent Portal. Your unique username and password to enable login to the Parent Portal will be sent two weeks prior to your child commencing school. For Years 7-12, orders will be available for collection by parents and students from the Uniform Shop. All online orders will be confirmed via email when your order is ready for collection.

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How to wear the Senior College Uniform

To and from school

The authorised school uniform, including blazers, MUST be worn TO and FROM school by all students. If travelling alone and after 4.30pm in the winter months, students may travel home in school sports clothing if they have been at a sports practice. Students may travel to school in sports uniform if they have sport, PE or PASS in Period 1-2.

At school

The full school uniform, including blazer is to be worn for formal occasions such as prizegiving, ceremonies, Showcase and Services.

Blazers

· To and from school

Blazers are compulsory throughout the school year. They are to be worn to and from school, during Chapel, to school events, excursions, school photographs and when representing the school.

Layering

Blazers are to be the outer garment, jumpers, cardigans and vests can be worn underneath. On extremely hot days, an exemption may be given to remove blazers. A decision will be made by the Deputy Head and students will be advised by their teachers.

Badges

The School Badge and House Badge are worn on the left side of the blazer collar. Other School Merit Badges are also permitted to be worn on the blazers.

Braiding and Honour Strips

The award of Academic Honours entitles a student to have 'Academic Honours' with the semester and year embroidered on their blazer. Braiding is awarded to Senior College students who are members of 1sts ISA teams, senior members of music or drama ensembles. Braiding is only awarded to students in the Senior College. Braiding for both genders is blue and white striped piping around the lapel of the blazer.

Care and maintenance

Blazers are to be kept clean, tidy, and have no missing buttons. Blazers should be dry cleaned and repaired at the end of each term.

General school uniform

- Boys ties are to be worn with the school uniform at all times at an appropriate length.
 All ties must be straight and neat.
- Shirts and blouses are to be tucked in at all times, with top button fastened.
- Skirt, dress and tunic length must be on the knee.
- Students must wear leather school shoes when carrying out practical work in Science, TAS, or VA. They can wear leather shoes with their PE uniform if necessary, in class.

Unable to wear the uniform?

If a student is unable to wear the uniform due to an injury or other unforseen circumstance, they should provide a note, signed by their parent or caregiver, to their Head of Year at the beginning of the day. If a student does not wear the uniform correctly, they will receive a uniform infringement and be asked to correct their uniform. Three infringements in a term may result in an afternoon detention. If a student comes to School out of uniform they may be excluded from classes and/or sent home. Incorrect jewellery may be confiscated for at least a term.

Students who are unsure about these rules can contact their Head of Year (by email or in person) for clarification.

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Name tag labels

All uniform items should be labelled with the student's name – using either a laundry marker or labels. Alternatively, go to www.thatsmine.com.au and quote school code 2133 or 'St Andrew's Cathedral School' (quote reference in customer comments box when checking out) for a wide range of stick on and iron on labels.

Stationery

Year 10:

Stationery must be purchased at the Uniform Shop or, for **current** parents, via the online Uniform Shop web store. Login via the Parent Portal.

All **new** Year 8-10 students must purchase stationery packs from the Uniform Shop at the time of uniform fitting. Online pre-ordered stationery packs will be collected during tutor time on their first day of School. All current Year 8-10 students may also purchase stationery packs from the Uniform Shop.

Years 11 and 12:

Students may purchase stationery as required from the range available at the Uniform Shop.

Given the vast range of subjects covered in these years, there is no prescribed list of items to be purchased.

Teachers may advise students of the stationery required for individual subjects. Students' exercise books must be covered. The school coloured A4 exercise book covers must be purchased from the Uniform Shop by all students.

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Personal appearance

Girls hair

Neat and tidy

Hair must be completely tied back when hair length is below the collar. Hair is to be neat and tidy at all times – with navy or white elastic or ribbons. Avoid extremes of hairstyles.

Hair ties

School hair ties may also be worn and are available from the Uniform Shop. No oversized ribbons or bows.

Colour

Hair should be a natural single colour.

Boys hair

· Neat and tidy

Hair should be neat and tidy at all times, cut above the collar, ears and eyebrows.

Avoid extremes of hairstyles. No line designs, no shaved heads under 'number 2' level, unruly or unkept hairstyles. Tied back hair or top knots are not permitted. It is recognised that matters of style are subjective and while every effort is made to be explicit in hairstyle requirements, the Head of School's decision in these matters is final.

Colour

Hair should be a natural single colour.

Facial hair

Face to be clean shaven with sideburn no lower than the earlobe.

Jewellery and Makeup

Jewellery

Girls may wear a single pair of pierced earrings in plain gold or silver, small sleeper or stud style. No other jewellery is acceptable for either boys or girls.

Makeup

Makeup is not to be worn at school.

Fingernails

Fingernails are to be short, well-groomed and without colour varnish.

· Tattoos, skin drawings, or body piercings

Visible tattoos, skin drawings, or body piercings are not permitted.



- Navy trousers

- Black lace-up shoes (see page 11 for examples)
- Hat: bucket hat or cap (for playground and sport) - not pictured

- Hat: bucket hat or cap (for playground and sport) - not pictured

Optional items - all year round:

- Grey school jumper or vest
- School scarf
- House or commemorative tie
- Optional school winter weather proof coat to wear over the blaze



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Sports uniform



- House crested polo
- Navy shorts with crest
- Plain white sports socks with no markings or motifs
- Sports runners or cross trainers (see below)
- Crested tracksuit jacket, navy with white pin stripe
- School tracksuit pants, navy with white pin stripe
- Hat: bucket hat or sports cap (for playground and sport) - not pictured

Sports shoes TO BE WORN ON SPORTS DAYS, PE, DRAMA OR PASS ONLY

- Shoes to have adequate foot support required for physical activity
- Non-marking sole
- No neon colours or light up shoes



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Hats

St Andrew's Cathedral School hats are compulsory for school sport/PE and must be worn at all sporting events

- · Sports cap; or
- Bucket hat (compulsory for all K 2 students)



School shoes

- Plain, black lace-up, low heel leather shoe.
- Must be kept shiny and polished.
- No Mary Janes/buckle style shoes and no jogger style shoes.
- No coloured stitching/laces.
- Velcro fastening shoes are permitted for Kindergarten only.
- ROC school shoes are available from the Uniform Shop or may be purchased elsewhere to school requirements.



Bags

No markings/ornaments are to be used on school bags

- Backpack medium/large Compulsory
- Sports bag medium/large Compulsory
- Folio bag
 Optional (compulsory for Year 7)
- Satchel
 Optional (Years 10-12 only)



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Co-curricular teamwear

Students are required to wear the full co-curricular teamwear for their chosen sport when representing the School. Failure to have the correct teamwear may result in a uniform infringement and three infringements in the term may result in an afternoon detention. In the cooler months, students are required to wear the school tracksuit or the optional Saturday Sport fleece only.

Sports uniform

Compulsory

School sports uniforms are COMPULSORY for ALL Year 7-10 students. For cooler weather there is also a tracksuit, which can be worn all year round.

To and from school

Year 7-10 students may wear PE uniform all day on the day they have PE Sport lessons. Design & Technology students may wear leather shoes with PE uniform if necessary. Otherwise, students must change into relevant PE uniform for PE/Dance/PASS classes; for those classes they can arrive to school in PE uniform if Period 1 or 2 and go home in PE uniform if Period 4 or 5. Students who compete in weekend school sport and training are required to wear the relevant TEAM sportswear, school swimwear and school tracksuit.

Sports training

Students can wear PE or sports uniform, or correct chosen sport teamwear, to training before and after school.

First (1st) teamwear

Students selected for all 1st Teams divisions will be given one sports kit to represent the School. Replacement costs for lost 1st Team uniform items will be charged to the student's account.

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Senior College Years 10-12 co-curricular teamwear

Winter sport

At St Andrew's Cathedral School, participation in a winter sport and/or co-curricular activity is **compulsory** for Years 7-11 students. Students will be told when to purchase teamwear uniform items once their Winter sport choice has been confirmed.

Winter sport options include:

The full school uniform is required to be worn for the following co-curricular activities:

The school sport/PE uniform is required to be worn for the following co-curricular activity:

- Fit 4 Life
- Squash

Students will be required to attend at least one training session per week, along with Saturday matches against other independent schools, or internal games on the weekend.

Other sports that may be available during the year are gymnastics, oz-tag, tee-ball, volleyball, ultimate frisbee and skiing. Required uniforms would be discusses upon selection in these teams.
